

Famed primatologist Jane Goodall returns to Malaysia

WITH her second visit to Malaysia, world-renowned primatologist and UN messenger of peace Dame Dr Jane Goodall hopes to inspire people to find a purpose in life.

Centred on instilling a sense of wonder within the youth by making a difference in their lives, she is hosting a public talk, titled "Finding Life's Passion", at Manhattan Ballroom, Berjaya Times Square Kuala Lumpur on Oct 29.

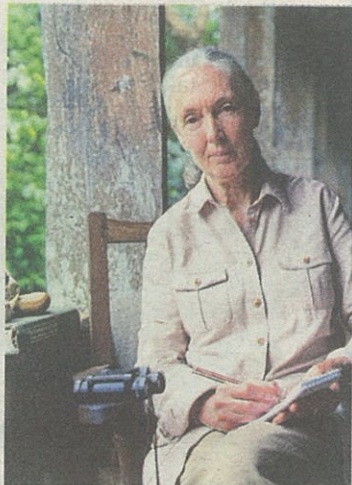
The talk is open to 2,000 participants as part of the Jane Goodall's Roots & Shoots Malaysia (R&S) initiative tied with Berjaya Youth (B. Youth).

"She decided to do the talk because young people these days seem unsure of what they should do, being lost in their journey through adolescence," said R&S project manager Jyunichi Washizaki.

"I think she hopes to inspire people to find their purpose by sharing her life experience on how she found her passion."
